## **GCSE Science**

In year 11 the majority of our students are following the **AQA Additional Science** course leading to their second Science GCSE. The exception is the **separate scientists (11A1).** 

Most students have completed their first Core Science GCSE. We have identified a cohort of students who will benefit from resitting the course. This only applies to about 25 students only, who have a target grade of C or above and who didn't get a grade C or above in year 10. The remaining students have already achieved a definite grade. The students who are resitting will be EXPECTED to attend revision sessions on Mondays after school, but will also be expected to revise fully at home. The resits are purely for the benefit of students, (which is the reason we are here!!) These will not count towards the schools final figures.

Mock exams - November/ December 14 -

- Additional science students will take two half hour exams.
- Core resit students will take 3 one hour exams. (B1, C1 AND P1)
- Separate scientists will take 3 one hour exams. (B2, C2 AND P2)

Plus one sessions will be run before these to help students revise.

For the Additional Science grade, **all students** on the course will sit three 1hr exams in May 2015. Coursework is an ISA (investigative skills assessment) completed in lesson time between January and February half term. Attendance for these lessons is imperative. The coursework ISA is worth 25% of the final grade. (Most students have already completed 1 piece of ISA coursework for additional science in June 14.)

### Dates for your diary are:

- Core Science exams (re-sits)
  - o Biology Friday 5<sup>th</sup> June 2015
  - o Chemistry Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> June 2015
  - o Physics Friday 12<sup>th</sup> June 2015
- Additional Science exams
  - o Biology Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> May 2015
  - Chemistry Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> May 2015
  - o Physics Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> May 2015
- The Separate Science group take **ALL** of the above exams, plus biology 3, chemistry 3 and physics 3. These exams are on the same day as biology 2, chemistry 2 and physics 2.

Again, it is imperative that students are not absent on the dates of these exams. These exams CANNOT be taken again and if students are absent for 1 exam they will simply get a zero mark for that exam!
